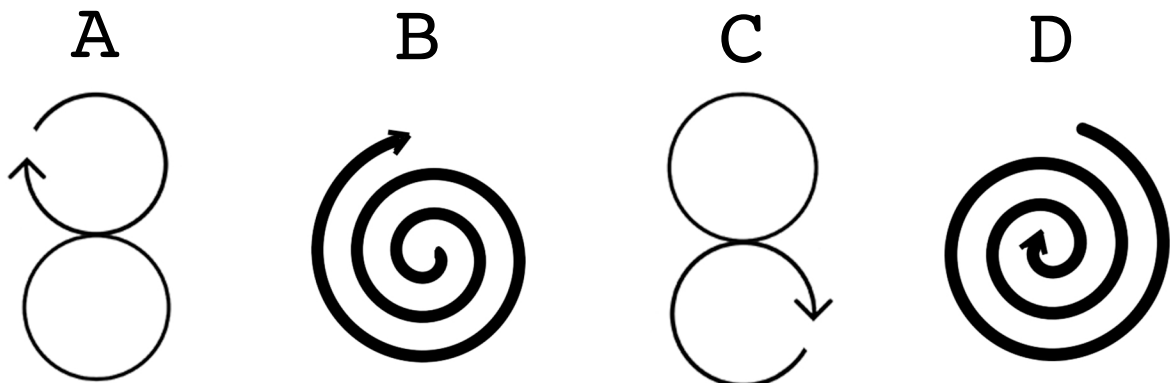


MUSIC FOR VOICE  
for 4 tam-tams  
Raven Chacon  
2003

- 4 performers, each with a superball (\*superball with nail-file handle) and each with a suspended large or medium tam-tam.
- The performers determine a duration between 4 and 7 minutes and divide the performance into 4 parts. The transition to each part happens when all players hear that the change in music has occurred.
- On a predetermined cue, the performers begin to rub their tam-tam with their superball, while visibly 'mouthing' the 'words' that they hear emanating from their tam-tam.
- Performers rub these shapes onto their tam-tam for the 4 sections:



Performer #1: B C D A  
Performer #2: C D A B  
Performer #3: D A B C  
Performer #4: A B C D

- The performance ends after the approximate predetermined duration when all performers believe that that time span has passed.
